# Confirmation & Renewal of Commitment to Christian Service

In the Baptism liturgy the priest says to the child:

"You are now a pilgrim with us. As a member of Christ's body, the Church, you will be challenged to affirm your faith in God and receive the Laying on of Hands in Confirmation. May you grow in the Holy Spirit, fulfil your ministry and follow Christ your whole life long."

The Anglican Parish of Greater Hastings is challenging you, and offering you the opportunity, to affirm your faith in God and receive The Laying on of Hands for Confirmation, or Renewal of your commitment to Christ's service.

Bishop Andrew Hedge is to be with us at St Matthew's, Hastings on Sunday 25 September 2022 and at St Peter's, Riverslea on Sunday 2 July 2023 to share in Patronal Festivities including Confirmation & Renewal of Commitment to Christian Service.

Confirmation is one of the sacramental actions that the Church provides. At Baptism we become members of Christ and therefore members of his Church. In Confirmation we 'confirm' our baptismal vows — usually made in infancy by parents and godparents on our behalf — and claim the promises and responsibilities of Baptism as our own.

In the early Church, Baptism and Confirmation were part of the one rite, but as the custom of infant baptism became more general, the Church deemed it wise to delay Confirmation until the baptised person was old enough to understand the privileges and responsibilities of Christian faith. Nowadays, in Confirmation we 'come of age' in the Church.

Confirmation is performed by the Bishop who, by the outward and visible sign of the laying on of hands with prayer, calls down upon the candidates the gift of the Holy Spirit. In this action the candidates receive the inward and spiritual grace of the Spirit to strengthen and confirm them in their act of adult Christian commitment.

#### A bit more about Confirmation & Renewal

Confirmation is the Laying on of Hands by means of which we receive the strengthening gifts of the Holy Spirit.

If you are Baptised, you are already a member of the Church. In Confirmation you affirm your faith and place in the life of the Church. The Bishop places hands upon your head and asks God to strengthen you for the job which is yours as a member of the Church. That job is Christian service.

The word *confirm* is used in two ways. First it means to ratify or say 'yes' to what someone else has said for us. We *confirm* the promises made for us in Baptism. Secondly, it means 'to strengthen' as in the Holy Communion where the priest says "Almighty God ... confirm and strengthen you in all goodness". We are confirmed and strengthened by the Holy Spirit through this service.

There are two parts to the Order of Confirmation. In the first, the person to be confirmed is presented to the Bishop, who represents the whole Church. The Candidate hears the lesson, which tells how the early Christian Church used this same ceremony that has come down to us through the ages. The Candidate promises the Bishop (and so therefore promises the whole Church) that they will try to live up to the promises made on their behalf when they were baptised. The Candidate is now going to stand on their own feet! They *confirm*, or say 'yes' to, those baptismal promises. In this first part of the service the person being confirmed is the main actor.

In the second part, God the Holy Spirit is the main actor. The Holy Spirit *confirms* – that is, strengthens – the person. The Bishop lays hands on the person's head. This action is the 'means whereby we receive this grace, and a pledge to assure us thereof.' Thus we follow the ancient practice of the Church. The closing prayers and blessing in this service are not only for the newly confirmed, but for all the people present that they may live according to God's laws.

As Baptism makes us a member of the Church, so Confirmation strengthens us in this fellowship and helps us fulfil our new responsibilities in the ministry of all the baptised.

Just as a new Deacon or Priest is ordained to that order of ministry in the Church, so by Confirmation you are commissioned to the lay order, and have your part to play in the worship and work of the Church in the world.

Would you like to reflect on what things were promised for you in Baptism are we confirming? What are some of the responsibilities of lay people and what is the ministry of all the baptised?

2021 was our fourth year catering for the Men's Fellowship lunch at St Matthew's church hall.

Lunches are usually held on the 4th Wednesday of each month, from February to October. We serve a two course meal for \$10, including tea and coffee. Numbers attending range from mid to high 20s. Those attending include men, not only from this parish, but also within our community, and men who may be on their own. All are very welcome to join our group. John Harding, with assistance from Richard,

co-ordinates the men, telephoning them each month to remind them, also checking on their attendance. Following lunch there is a guest speaker or a general knowledge quiz.

217 meals were served during the 8 months, total monthly average was 27 meals for the year. Our lunches are a fund raiser for Waiapu Anglican Missions. We are delighted to report this year our donation to this Mission of \$1,055. It is very rewarding to see the men enjoying the lunch and fellowship each month. If you would like to support this work, we need one lady helper each month from 11.30am until approximately 2.30pm helping usually twice a year. If you are interested in either attending the lunch or helping serve the meals, please contact us.




